# Agreed report: Board of Management Meeting 17/9/2020

### 1.Minutes:

The minutes of the previous meeting (20th July) were proposed and seconded.

### 2. Matters arising:

Hours for two full-time S.N.A. positions have been allocated to the new Aoibhneas unit in the school and this allocation will be organized in the near future.

#### 3. Correspondence:

 A letter from Túsla confirmed that no further action will be taken with regard to the recent Child Protection issue for which they were contacted.

# 4. Principal's Report:

- 1. The school has currently 480 pupils enrolled.
- 2. Section 4 of the Enrolment Policy has been amended to include the new ASD special
- 3. class,"A oibhneas."
- 4. The class structures (ie single classes) remain the same.
- 5. The school currently has 19 classes, 4 SN 's, 1 special class (Aoibhneas) with allocation
- 6. for a further two SNA s.
- 7. There was extensive work done to the buildings and grounds of the school over the
- 8. summer months (new furniture, painting, signage, new flooring, etc). The classrooms
- 9. were all deep-cleaned and sanitizer and paper-towel dispensers were installed
- 10. throughout the school. The chairperson complimented the principal on his hard work
- 11. over the last few months. The principal acknowledged the role of the deputy -principal
- 12. in this work also.
- 13. Public Health Guidelines were strictly adhered to following the recent incident of Covid-
- 14. 19 within the school.
- 15. A Seniority list of staff has been drawn up and displayed in the staff-room.
- 16. Confirmation Ceremonies will take place for the previous sixth classes on the 21st and
- 17. 22nd of October in Turner's Cross Church.
- 18. Applications for new pupils will be within a given time-frame and according to the
- 19. criteria outlined in the Admission policy of the school. The criteria for admission to the
- 20. special class, Aoibhneas, have also been outlined in the policy.
- 21. Scoil Bhríde will lose a teacher next year; the chairperson suggested a long-term strategy
- 22. for pupil-enrolment is needed.
- 23. Pupil online-data is to be forwarded to the Department.

# 6. Anti-Bullying Report:

There were no incidents of bullying reported.

# 7. Funding:

□ The Board sanctioned a further 6,000 euro to fund the fencing of the Sensory Garden on the grounds and the flooring for the Aoibhneas unit.
